- Our outdoor classrooms are the shore of Ninigret Pond, the lowlands of the adjacent Ninigret National Wildlife Refuge, and the undeveloped barrier beach in the Ninigret Conservation Area in Charlestown, RI.
- Our indoor facilities are our Observatory, our new Sky Theatre, and our Nature Center.
- Our teachers are experts in marine biology, biological oceanography, astronomy, physics, mathematics, botany, geology, Native American history, and more.
